

All students are required to wear full and correct uniform each day including travel to and from school. The College community has selected a smart and practical uniform which does not place undue financial stress on parents. Parents are required to be supportive of the uniform expectations.

We have two uniforms at Kearnan College, the formal uniform and sports uniform. The formal uniform is worn on most days of the week. The sports uniform is worn on Wednesdays as well as other sports days (in primary school) and for sport lessons (in secondary school).

FORMAL UNIFORM

BOYS

- College collared checkered green shirt
- College charcoal shorts or trousers
- Green woollen jumper
- Black College Jacket (not sports jacket)
- Black lace up school shoes (not sneakers)
- Plain black socks
- Green Kearnan bucket hat



GIRLS

- College checkered dress or the College checkered green shirt and College charcoal shorts or trousers
- Green woollen jumper
- Black College Jacket (not sports jacket)
- Black lace up school shoes (not sneakers)
- Plain white socks
- Green Kearnan bucket hat

Students selected for representative teams may have different uniform requirements and relevant students will be notified of the requirements upon selection.

Parents cannot give students permission to wear incorrect uniform or deviate from the uniform expectations – they must seek permission from the College prior to the student arriving at school.

PRE-PRIMARY AND KINDERGARTEN UNIFORM

The below uniform is compulsory for Pre-Primary students and encouraged for Kindy students.

Requirements are:

- Red polo shirt with Kearnan Kids logo
- Red windcheater with Kearnan Kids logo
- Black Kearnan shorts
- Black Kearnan tracksuit pants or plain black leggings
- Green Kearnan bucket hat
- Enclosed shoes

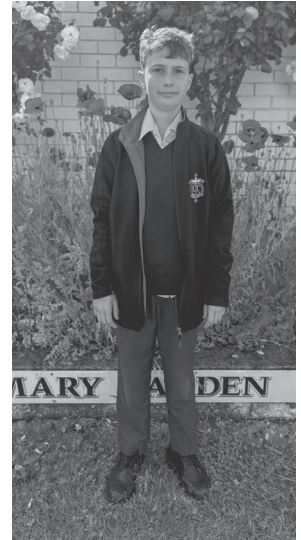
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FORMAL UNIFORM

Students selected for representative teams may have different uniform requirements and relevant students will be notified of the requirements upon selection.

Students who have Physical Education lessons in Period 6 are not required to change out of their sports uniform before leaving the College grounds.

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UNIFORM ACCESSORIES

All students MUST wear the College hat during recess and lunch in Term 1 and 4, and during Physical Education lessons. Green College beanies are an option in winter for added warmth (no other beanie will be permitted). A black College scarf is also available. No hats/beanies are to be worn in class.

FREE DRESS

On days students are permitted to wear free dress they must ensure it is smart and appropriate dress. Inappropriate logos and wording on clothing is not acceptable. In order to meet occupational health and safety standards, thongs and other open shoes are not permitted. Slipper style shoes are also not permitted. Closed sturdy shoes must be worn at all times. Students are required to ensure they have the correct sports uniform with them during free dress days.

HAIR STYLES AND ACCESSORIES

Students are to keep their hair neat and tidy at all times. Extremes of cut, style or colour are not permitted. If in doubt check with the College first. In the interests of safety and hygiene, hair that is long enough to tie back, or touch collar of shirt, must be worn off the face and tied up. (This applies to boys and girls). Hair accessories may be red, green, white or natural.

Hair may only be dyed one completely natural colour such as blonde, black, brown. Multiple colours are not acceptable.

JEWELLERY

The wearing of jewellery whilst in school uniform is not considered necessary, however, if worn it is to be limited to the following:

- a watch.
- a small cross or medal of religious significance worn on a fine chain around the neck.
- one sleeper earring or stud worn in the lobe of each ear.

No other jewellery, including rings, piercings or body adornments are considered to be appropriate as part of this uniform expectations. Body piercings are not permitted.

GENERAL APPEARANCE

Make-up is generally not permitted to be worn except in the case of some skin conditions. In this case please refer to the College office. Students will be asked to remove make-up.

Nail polish is not permitted to be worn and students will be asked to remove it.

Boys are to be clean shaven each day.
